ALMOST GOLF BALLS

Practice makes perfect, and Tiger is a perfect example of this truism.

Problem for the rest of us, however, is that we have our daytime jobs, and our backyards aren't of golf course length. So we watch golf videos, read instructional books on golf swings, and play whenever we squeeze in the time between weddings, kid's soccer games, and Saturday overtime work.

How about once, *just for once*, can't we just practice golf when it comes to spin, fades, draws and golf swings without having to pay \$10 a bucket at the local range?

Invented for that purpose and touted as *The Ultimate Practice Golf Ball*, Almost Golf Balls is the first limited distance golf ball with true flight characteristics, meaning you can hit it straight, play a fade or hit a draw without worry that you're going to break the neighbor's window. Or, you can just stop at the local park and off the highway and hit away! Almost Golf Balls are six times heavier than a whiffle ball and almost four times lighter than a regular golf ball.

With its weight advantage for practice, including putting, Almost Golf Balls is constructed of cross-linked foaming which provides memory, bounce and durability. Travelling one-third the distance of regular golf balls, Almost Golf Balls feature 1/8th millimeter deep dimples, which duplicate true golf ball trajectory and flight characteristics. Almost Golf Balls decompress slightly upon impact, but immediately resume



shape. A "pop" is heard off the club face upon impact, and it's safe for practice in that it's not going to break windows or jaws.
